Completion of the Diploma program requires 30 credit hours (10 one-semester courses) plus a non-credit Entry Colloquium (normally taken during the first semester of study). At least 21 credit hours must be St. Andrew's courses.

A student must complete **at least seven courses from the following list**, or acceptable equivalents. Regular courses carry three hours of credit; Learning Circles carry 4.5 credit hours. Those with prerequisites are marked with an asterisk.

The **other 9 credit hours may be either taken from the list or may be electives** chosen in consultation with a Faculty Advisor.

Students may request that the Faculty transfer up to 9 credit hours of equivalent work from other accredited institutions. Students may also apply for credit through Prior Learning Assessment.

There is no time limit on completion of the Diploma program
